Parents / Spectators



- Remember that children play sport for their enjoyment, not yours
- Encourage in your support
- Encourage them to play by the rules
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success
- Teach children that winning isn't the be all and end all
- Set a good example - applaud good play by ALL
- Publicly accept officials' decisions and teach children to do likewise
- Be courteous to all
- Show appreciation of volunteers, officials and coaches



- Ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game - mistakes are a part of learning
- Abuse or yell at officials, coach/teacher or volunteer - young players can't play the game without them
- Force your child to take part in sport
- Threaten or intimidate
- Use inappropriate language
- Confuse the players by telling them what to do or coaching them - let the teacher/coach do their job
- Do anything which is likely to offend by way of insult, humiliation or discrimination.
